Reflection and Facilitation questions:

Thank you for your enthusiastic participation!

Could we ask each of the participants to read their character sketch?

How did you feel when participating in this activity?

What did you consider when making your moves?

Why could you or could you not move forward?

How did you feel when you moved forward?

Where are the men? Where are the women? Where are the rich and the poor?

What does this tell us about vulnerability?

What are the implications of these dynamic for adaptation efforts?

How could we change the vulnerability status quo?

Ask specific characters for details on specific questions -

The detractors and the enablers

Relational aspect between the farmers

What do you think we were trying to demonstrate through this game?

Ask also someone watching - how they felt about what was happening?

What do they think that was happening?

What were you able to learn from the game?

Objectives of this exercise

- 1. To show how different groups begin at different levels of power
- 2. To assess at each step how power operates
- 3. To elicit the inter-relationships between power of different groups
- 4. To visualize the role of agency in the manifestation of pathways
